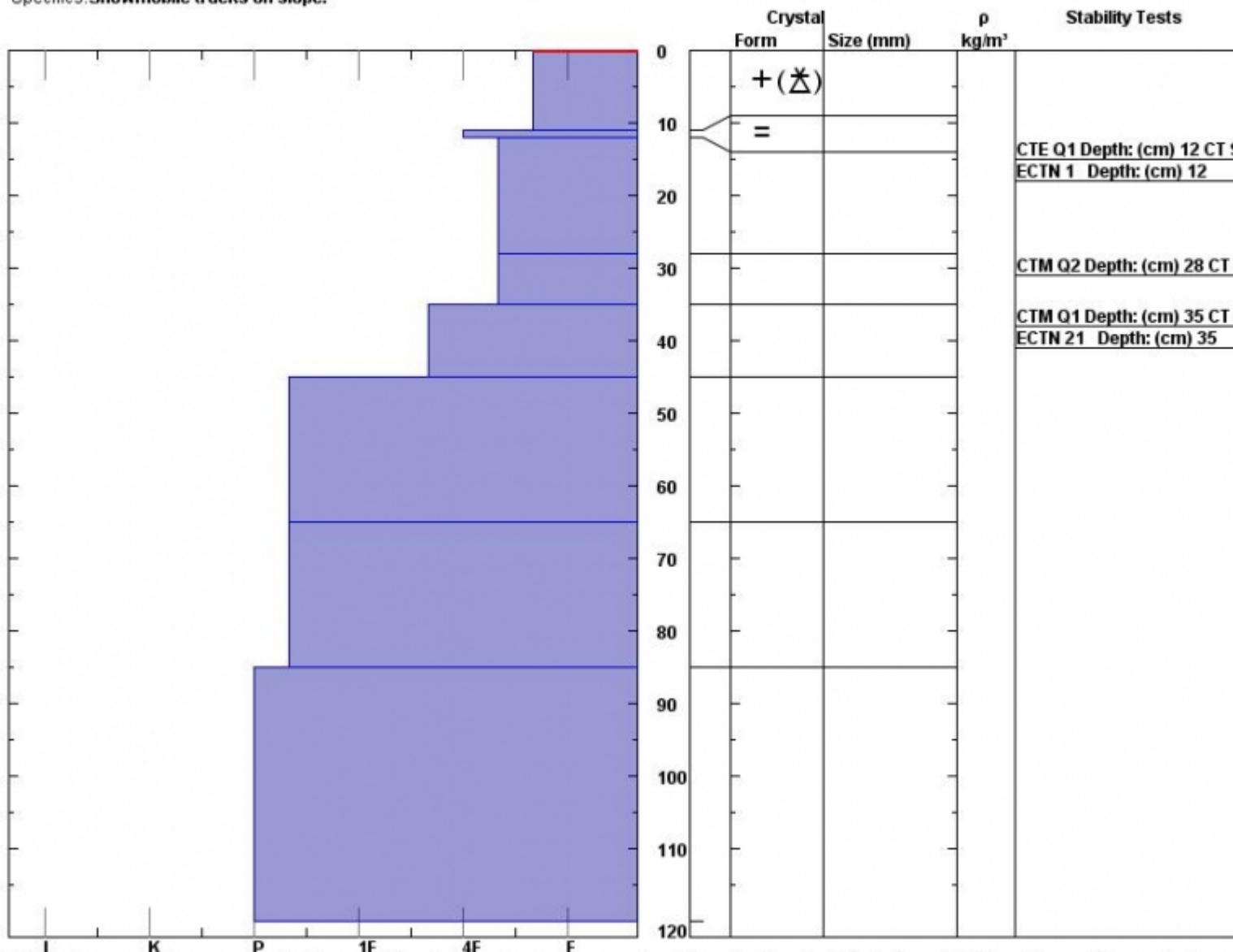

Notes: Deep and strong snowpack. Some sluffing of graupel and new snow at surface. Brief period of rain at onset of latest storm. Rain created a crust that appears to cause any trouble. New snow is warm and will bond well. At 35 cm there were no facets, just some preserved stellars that have a slight hardness than surrounding layers, but very hard to find in pit wall.
