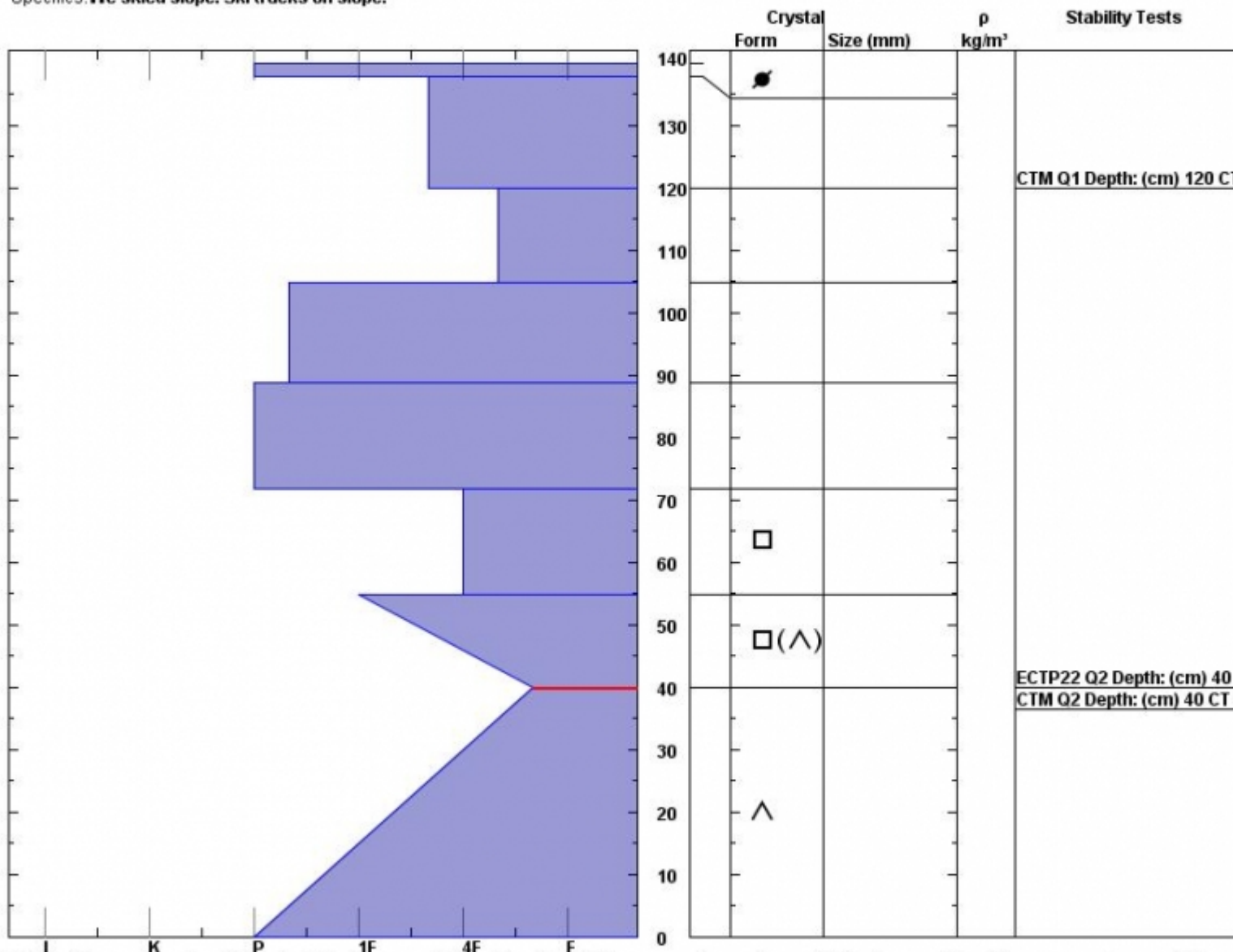

Notes: This was dug about 75 feet off the ridgecrest. Weak facets/depth hoar are not very strong. No load=no problem. The snowpack seems to have load and might continue to do so if the storms are small. Adjacent to the pit site the snow was only 40 cm deep (facets) and I worry that a collapse initiate and propagate onto the slope.
