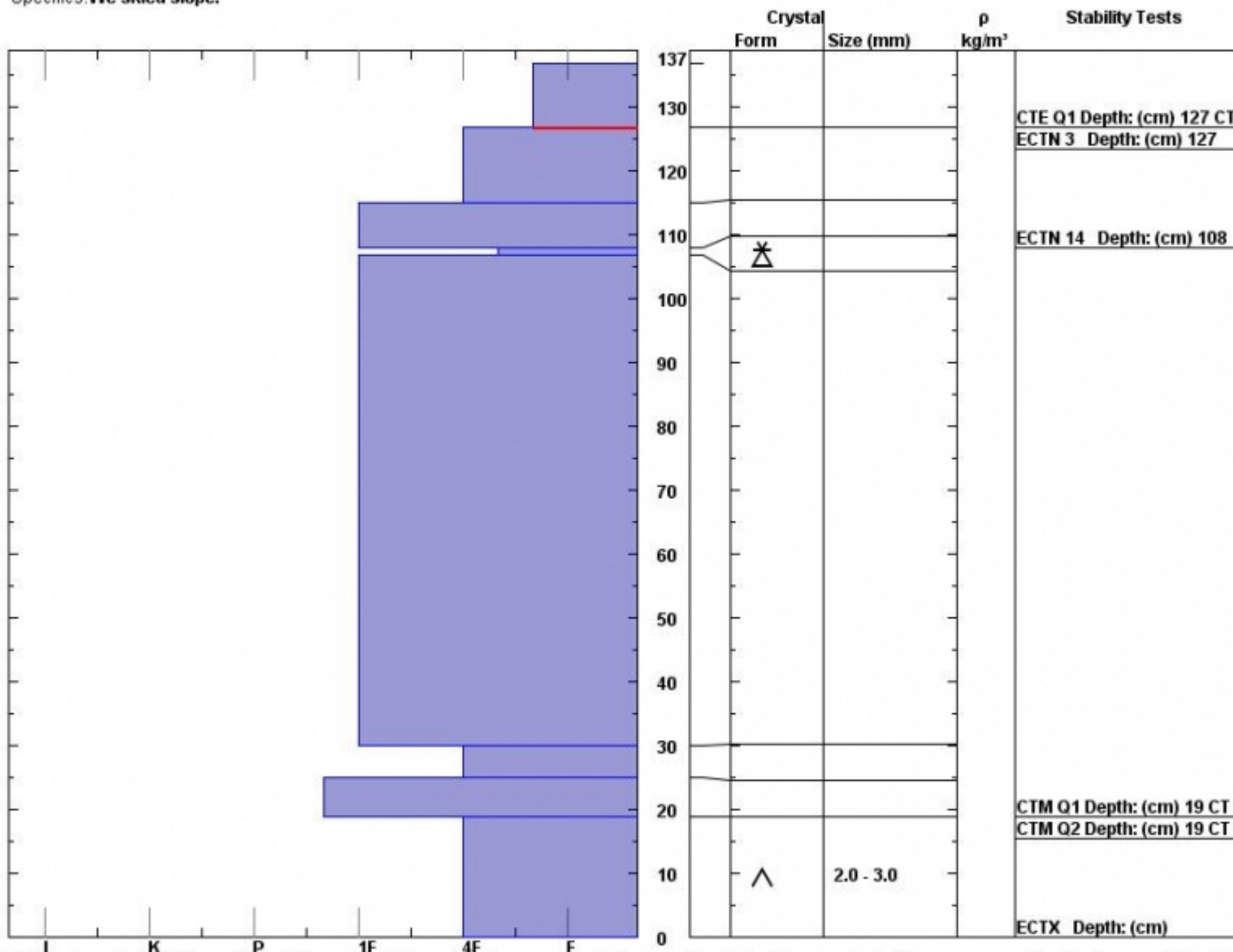

Notes: Ground was talus with depth hoar. Probably as weak as you would find it in this basin. Easy breaks in the new snow which had some wind effect stiff in places. Generally about 4 inches deep and breaking on old stellars. Possible concern if you could find a place with more wind deposited couldn't. Unlikely that avalanches would occur on DH near ground.
